

DSK's "Clean Sweep!" Card Game

Card Values:

1. Number cards stand for the number,
2. Picture cards mean "x" or multiply
3. Jokers can stand for any number or "multiply".

Basic Play:

1. Pass out 3 cards per person
2. Place 4 cards face up in the middle
3. Player to the dealer's left goes first. Players take turns dealing cards.
4. With one card from your hand see if you can make a math fact from one of the table cards. Say you have a 5 and the table cards are 3, 7, A, K, you can make 5×7 . Say "5 times 7" and then give the answer. If you are correct you get to keep the cards, otherwise you leave them on the table.
5. If you cannot make a math fact, you have to "table" a card.
6. When all table cards are gone, the dealer places four more cards on the table, face up. The person who "Sweeps" the last card gets a "Clean Sweep" point.
7. When all the players have played their cards the dealer passes out three new cards to each player.
8. If the players cannot get the same number of cards on the final play, the extra card is "tabled".
9. The last person able to get a math fact correct at the end of the game takes the remaining cards and gets a "Last Card" point.

Picture Cards:

1. Say you have a 2 and the table cards are 2, 7, 6, K. You can make 2×7 , but the picture card counts as "x". Pick up the picture card and say, "2 times 7" and then give the answer. If you are correct you get to keep all THREE cards, otherwise you leave them on the table.
2. If you are holding a picture card you use it a "x", and then you can pick up two number cards from the table.
3. Jokers stand for any number or "x".

Counting the Points:

1. Person with "Most Cards" gets one extra point
2. Each "Clean Sweep" gets one extra point
3. Each "Diamond Card" gets one point
